Education Credit Union and H&H FCU Announce Partnership

Amarillo, Texas – Education Credit Union (ECU) and H&H FCU are pleased to announce that their Boards of Directors have unanimously voted to approve a partnership that will combine two great credit unions into an even stronger financial institution focused on creating significant value for consumers in the panhandle of Texas. The combined institution will have more than 34,000 members and 10 branch locations in Amarillo, Canyon, Bushland, Borger & Stinnett. “In light of our shared goals, shared commitment to our members and common scholastic roots, a mutual agreement was reached to add H&H FCU to the ECU family,” said Marcus Smith, ECU’s Interim CEO. “I’m excited about the expanded coverage and opportunity this will offer our members, our employees, and the panhandle community.”

H&H FCU CEO, Tina Hunter, echoed this sentiment, saying, “H&H Stinnett and H&H Borger will be great additions to the current ECU branch locations, and I’m excited about the expanded accounts, loans, and convenience this will deliver for our members.”

H&H Federal Credit Union was founded to serve persons who live, work, worship, or attend school in, Carson, Hansford, Hutchinson, and Moore Counties, which are located north and east of Amarillo and includes branches in Borger and Stinnett, Texas.

These efforts will expand branch coverage for members of both credit unions, and will expand accounts, loans, and financial services for current H&H FCU members.

The addition of these two branches to ECU is expected to be complete in early 2023.
